


Russian market for bakery and pastry shop equipment

In 2005, investments in new equipment in Russian food industry businesses rose by 35% compared to 2004, as reported by Russian Food and Drink magazine. About 71% of the equipment is imported. The largest suppliers are German companies. They provided 59% of the packaging and filling plants and 44% of all bakery and pastry shop equipment. Austria and Italy come in 2nd and 3rd for imports with 12% and 9% respectively. Among the suppliers to bakeries and pastry shops are Franz Haas Waffel- und Keksanlagen Industrie GmbH, Austria, and the German companies Hebenstreit GmbH, Chocotech GmbH, and Klöckner Hänsel Processing GmbH with an import share of 7–8% each, as well as Anton Ohlert

GmbH with 6%. Compared to 2004, the Russian production of food equipment rose in 2005 by 12%. One major manufacturer of bakery plants occupying 45% of the Russian production is the Wodschod Company in Saratow and this is followed by Belogorje in Schebekino/Belgorod region with 13% and the machine manufacturer Schebekino with 10%. Leading suppliers for pastry shop equipment are Amalko, Moscow, with 24%, Wodschod with 17% and Schebekino with 15%. The Russian production of plants and equipment for the food industry is not sufficient to fulfill the demand from this industry. The result is an open import market for this industry which has a modernization need of 65%. +++


Dictionary Grain Processing and Trade

In the beginning the other entries are irritating, especially because the typeface is really

small. Finding the individual sections for the languages is not that easy because there is no register or any other mark that limits the chapters visually from each other.

As far as the content of this dictionary is concerned, it is apparent that this is a work done by experts. Technical and specialist terms such as derrick, flaker, flour absorption, lesser grain borer, mill by-product, oil cake crusher, plan sifter and many more are included. With its detailed and extensive listings this dictionary is an essential purchase for all those involved in the international business of the sector: traders, processors, millers, suppliers, etc.
